

**AMENDMENT TO RULES 010.13-002, 004, 005, 009, 013, 022 and 023
OF THE BOARD OF ELECTRICAL EXAMINERS,
STATE OF ARKANSAS**

**AGENCY RESPONSE TO PUBLIC COMMENT
BEFORE THE BOARD ON NOVEMBER 17, 2015**

Associated General Contractors (AGC) of Arkansas submitted written comment on November 9, 2015 that supported the proposed regulation changes. At the public hearing, William French of the International Brotherhood of Electrical Workers (IBEW) asked what the apprentice ratio is under the proposed regulations. Staff attorney Daniel Faulkner responded that Act 1122 of 2015 designated the ratio is now 3:1, and that the Board doesn't have discretion to deviate from the Act. There were no further questions or comments.

Conclusion

The Board of Electrical Examiners has heard and reviewed public comment on the proposed changes. There was no negative comment on these changes, and the Board voted to proceed with the attached language.
