CONSENT ORDER

The Arkansas Department of Labor (hereinafter, ADOL) and Torrence D. Burson Sr. enter into this agreement to settle all issues relating to citations and assessments of civil money penalties issued by the Elevator Division of the ADOL. The parties agree and state the following:

1. Torrence D. Burson Sr. admits to one (1) violation of Arkansas law regarding the licensing of elevator mechanics, Ark. Code Ann. §§ 20-24-108 *et seq.*, or the regulations of the Board, on April 9, 2013.

2. The Department of Labor notified Torrence D. Burson Sr. of a civil penalty assessment in the amount of **\$1,000.00** for these violations.

3. Torrence D. Burson Sr. has not been previously disciplined or fined by the Board.


4. Torrence D. Burson Sr. specifically agrees to future compliance with Arkansas laws regarding licensing of elevator mechanics.

5. Torrence D. Burson Sr. and the ADOL agree that the above referenced fine in this matter shall be reduced to **\$250.00** provided there are no further violations of the state's licensing law as adopted by the Board, for a period of two years from entry of this agreement. Should any violations occur within this two-year period, the entire fine assessed shall be paid in full.
