OPINION/ORDER

This case comes on for review following a hearing on respondent's Motion to Dismiss.

Claimant suffered an admittedly compensable injury to her ankle on June 18, 2022. Claimant filed Form AR-C on June 21, 2022 requesting various compensation benefits. No further action was taken and no hearing was requested. As a result, respondent filed a motion to dismiss this claim on February 7, 2023. A hearing on respondent's motion was scheduled for April 17, 2023. Notice of the hearing was sent to claimant by certified mail and was delivered on March 9, 2023. Claimant did not appear at the hearing and has not responded to the respondent's motion. Counsel for respondent indicated that claimant had contacted their office and indicated that she had no objection to the

dismissal and would not be attending the hearing.
