ORDER

The claimant in the above-styled matter moves the Full Commission to strike certain portions of Respondent No. 2's brief. The Full Commission takes the motion under advisement.

The Full Commission filed an opinion in the above-styled matter on February 12, 2013. The Full Commission found that the claimant did not prove she was permanently totally disabled, but that the claimant proved she sustained wage-loss disability in the amount of 40%. The parties

stipulated that the Full Commission's February 12, 2013 opinion was final. An administrative law judge filed an opinion on September 21, 2020. The administrative law judge found, among other things, that the claimant "has failed to prove by a preponderance of the evidence that she is permanently totally disabled or that she is entitled to any additional wage loss benefits for a change in physical condition since the Full Commission opinion of February 12, 2013."

The claimant has filed a timely notice of appeal to the Full Commission. The parties have apparently briefed the Full Commission. In her motion, the claimant states that the Full Commission "should strike the portions of the Funds (sic) brief relating to findings of fact not appealed from the original ALJ's decision." The Full Commission takes the claimant's Motion To Strike under advisement pending our *de novo* review. We direct the Clerk of the Commission to place this matter on our submission docket.
