OPINION AND ORDER

Respondents appeal an opinion and order of the Administrative Law

Judge filed December 22, 2020. In said order, the Administrative Law

Judge made the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

- 1. The Commission has jurisdiction of this claim.
- 2. The stipulations to which the parties agreed in the Prehearing Order filed August 21, 2020, which the parties modified and affirmed on the record at the hearing, are hereby accepted as facts.

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 The claimant has proven by a preponderance of the credible evidence of record he is entitled to wage loss disability of 30% in excess of his 4% BAW permanent anatomical impairment rating.

- 4. The claimant's attorney is entitled to the maximum statutory attorney's fee on the controverted 30% wage loss disability award.
- 5. The respondents remain liable for any and all reasonably necessary medical care related to the claimant's June 11, 2019, left shoulder injury.

We have carefully conducted a *de novo* review of the entire record herein and it is our opinion that the Administrative Law Judge's December 22, 2020 decision is supported by a preponderance of the credible evidence, correctly applies the law, and should be affirmed. Specifically, we find from a preponderance of the evidence that the findings made by the Administrative Law Judge are correct and they are, therefore, adopted by the Full Commission.

We therefore affirm the decision of the Administrative Law Judge, including all findings of fact and conclusions of law therein, and adopt the opinion as the decision of the Full Commission on appeal.

All accrued benefits shall be paid in a lump sum without discount and with interest thereon at the lawful rate from the date of the Administrative Law Judge's decision in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. §11-9-809 (Repl. 2012).

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For prevailing on this appeal before the Full Commission, claimant's attorney is entitled to fees for legal services in accordance with Ark. Code Ann. § 11-9-715(Repl. 2012). For prevailing on appeal to the Full Commission, the claimant's attorney is entitled to an additional fee of five hundred dollars (\$500), pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §11-9-715(b)(Repl. 2012).
