Department of Labor and Licensing (ADLL) Report;

- The Legislative Audit of FY22 for ADLL and our agency continues.
- Board Members Appointments/reappointments – Those with a 7/1/2022 term end date; The Professional Surveyor position remains vacant, Donald Perry's reappointment was confirmed by the Senate on 2/1/2023 for the 2022-2026 term. On 7/1/2023 three others will be up for reappointment/appointment.

Vermeer, Eric Evan PE – Deny comity licensure, motion made (Beasley moved, Williams seconded) and carried – does not meet the Rule of the Board.




