The above-captioned matter came on for a hearing on April 27, 2021, upon the Respondents' (second) Motion to Dismiss, filed with the Commission on March 5, 2021. Respondent No. 2 was deemed to have waived appearance at such given its previous waiver of appearance for a prior hearing held on August 26, 2020, with respect to Respondent No. 1's initial Motion to Dismiss.

Based upon my review of the Commission's file, statements made by the Claimant and by

Counsel for Respondent No. 1 during the hearing, I specifically find that Respondent No. 1's

Motion to Dismiss should be, and hereby is, respectfully denied. The above-referenced matter will

be returned to the Commission's general files and no further action will be taken unless the Clerk

of the Commission is advised, in writing, of an additional hearing request. Respondent No. 1 is

hereby ordered and directed to pay the court reporter's fee within thirty (30) days of billing for

such.
