## OPINION AND ORDER FILED JULY 28, 2021

The above-captioned matter came on for a hearing on July 27, 2021, for consideration of the Respondents' Motion to Dismiss originally filed with the Commission on February 12, 2021, and following delays occasioned by the Claimant as reflected in the Commission's file. When the hall was sounded at the appointed time for the hearing, the Claimant was not present and did not appear during the ensuing proceedings. During such proceedings, Respondent's Exhibit No. 1 was introduced into the record without objection, and the Commission's file was designated as part of the record without objection. Review of both reflects that the Claimant filed a Form AR-C on May 26, 2020, has not requested a hearing on the merits since that date, and that the Commission has taken all available measures to inform the Claimant of the hearing date inclusive of first-class and certified mail dated July 13, 2021. Given the Claimant's failure to appear at the hearing, failure to object to the Respondent's motion, and apparent failure to otherwise timely prosecute his claim since May 26, 2020, I specifically find that this matter should be, and hereby is, dismissed without prejudice for lack of timely prosecution pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. §11-9-702 and Commission
