OPINION AND ORDER

Claimant appeals an opinion and order of the Administrative Law Judge filed March 1, 2023. In said order, the Administrative Law Judge made the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

- The stipulations agreed to by the parties at a pre-hearing conference conducted on December 14, 2022 and contained in a pre-hearing order filed that same date are hereby accepted as fact.
- 2. Claimant has failed to prove by a preponderance of the evidence that he suffered a compensable injury to his right shoulder on February 19, 2021.
