ORDER

This matter came before the HVAC/R (Heating, Ventilation, Air Conditioning/Refrigeration)

Board on Wednesday September 14, 2022. The petitioner, Jeremiah Webb, seeks approval for reinstatement of an HVAC/R Class B license which he is currently ineligible due to a prior felony conviction. The HVAC/R Board has authority to waive disqualification of a license based on a criminal conviction if the Board decides that the applicant meets requirements listed in the Ark. Code Annotated § 17-3-102(b)(2). Mr. Webb did appear before the Board via zoom for the hearing.

FINDING OF FACT:

- The petitioner ("Webb") is requesting the Board to reinstate his HVAC/R Class B license. Due to
 his prior felony conviction from September 2019, he is currently ineligible for reinstatement.
- Webb did appear before the Board via zoom.
- Staff reviewed documents and recommended approval based on personal and professional letters of recommendation.

CONCLUSIONS OF LAW:

 The Board has authority to waive disqualification of a license based on a criminal conviction pursuant to Ark. Code Ann. § 17-3-102(b)(1).

- 2. A basis upon which a waiver may be granted includes without limitation:
 - The age at which the offense was committed;
 - The circumstances surrounding the offense;
 - c. The length of time since the offense was committed;
 - d. Subsequent work history since the offense was committed;
 - e. Employment references since the offense was committed;
 - f. Character references since the offense was committed;
 - g. Relevance of the offense to the occupational license; and
 - Other evidence demonstrating that licensure of the applicant does not pose a threat to the health and safety of the public. Ark. Code Ann. § 17-3-102(b)(2).
- In the present case, the Board was informed of the nature of the criminal conviction and the facts surrounding the criminal conviction.
- The Board reviewed staff's recommendation to affirm a motion to approve Webb's request for reinstatement.
- The Board voted to reinstate Webb's HVAC/R Class B license.

THEREFORE, the Board reinstates Jeremiah Webb HVAC/R Class B license. IT IS SO ORDERED.
