

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

A specially scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission began at 11:30 a.m. in the Governor's Conference Room at the Arkansas State Capitol. The purpose of this meeting was to present the grant checks to the recipients of the Education and Training and Grant Program. All Commissioners were present during the meeting with the exception of Foster Davis, which was an excused absence. Also in attendance were Governor Hutchinson, a number of members of the Governor's staff, and all eleven recipients of the grant funds. Staff present included Sandy Stroope, Robert Galloway, Gordon McCoy, Crystal Campbell, and Tanelle Hymes.

The following institutions received grants: Arkansas State University at Beebe/Searcy Campus, Cabot High School, UA Cossatot, Ouachita Career Center, Gentry High School Conversion Charter, Pulaski Technical College, Waldron High School, Northwest Technical Institute, NEA Career & Technical Center, Monticello Occupational Education Center, each awarded \$13,750.00; and Arkansas Tech Career Center awarded \$12,500.00.

Following the grant presentation in the Governor's Conference Room, the recipients, Commissioners, and Commission staff held a reception honoring these awardees in the Victory Building. Commission Chair Joy Blankenship and Sandy Stroope made brief remarks to the recipients about the program.
