

MINUTES OF THE ARKANSAS MOTOR VEHICLE COMMISSION

The regularly scheduled meeting of the Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission was called to order at 9:30 a.m. by Vice Chairman Bobby Ferguson. Staff present included Executive Director Greg Kirkpatrick, License Supervisor Vicki Wright, Investigator Gordon McCoy, and Administrative Specialist Crystal Campbell. All Commissioners were present during the meeting with the exception of Sandy Stroope. Also in attendance were Mark Ohrenberger with the Attorney General's Office; Court Reporter Susan Whitson; and Hearing Officer Cathleen Compton.

The minutes from the April 16, 2014, meeting were reviewed and approved unanimously as written following a proper motion and second.

The Commission unanimously approved the expenditures for the May 21, 2014, meeting following a proper motion and second.

The fiscal reports for April 2014 were reviewed and approved unanimously following a proper motion and second.


Director Kirkpatrick reviewed the license activity report, summary of revenue, investigation summary, and the consumer assistance report.

There were no ad hoc meeting recommendations that required approval. There was not a legal brief report presented.

The Commission moved on the agenda to H#14-010, Arkansas Motor Vehicle Commission ("AMVC") vs. HomeTown ATV & More, Inc. ("HomeTown"). Following testimony, the Commission found the violations of Commission statutes and rules by HomeTown warrant a revocation of Respondent's license for failure to comply with provisions of the Commission Act and Rules promulgated by the Commission as per Ark. Code Ann. § 23-112-308(a)(4).

Vice Chairman Ferguson accepted a proper motion and second to adjourn the meeting.
