OPINION AND ORDER

Claimant appeals an opinion and order of the Administrative Law Judge filed October 28, 2020. In said order, the Administrative Law Judge made the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

- The stipulations agreed to by the parties at a pre-hearing conference conducted on June 3, 2020 and contained in a pre-hearing order filed that same date are hereby accepted as fact.
- Claimant has failed to meet her burden of proving by a preponderance of the evidence that she suffered a compensable injury to her spine on November 14, 2018.

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We have carefully conducted a *de novo* review of the entire record herein and it is our opinion that the Administrative Law Judge's October 28, 2020 decision is supported by a preponderance of the credible evidence, correctly applies the law, and should be affirmed. Specifically, we find from a preponderance of the evidence that the findings of fact made by the Administrative Law Judge are correct and they are, therefore, adopted by the Full Commission.

Therefore we affirm and adopt the decision of the Administrative Law Judge, including all findings and conclusions therein, as the decision of the Full Commission on appeal.
