ORDER

In the above-styled matter, Respondent No. 1 moves the Full Commission to reconsider our opinion filed July 27, 2022. We also deny the claimant's request for attorney's fees. A fee is payable from the employer or carrier only if benefits are

controverted and awarded. Burton v. Chartis Claims, Inc., 2014 Ark. App.

The Full Commission therefore denies Respondent No. 1's motion for reconsideration, and we deny the claimant's request for attorney's fees. IT IS SO ORDERED.
