OPINION AND ORDER

Claimant appeals an opinion and order of the Administrative Law Judge filed June 16, 2021. In said order, the Administrative Law Judge made the following findings of fact and conclusions of law:

- 1. The stipulations agreed to by the parties at a pre-hearing conference conducted on December 9, 2020 and contained in a pre-hearing order filed that same date are hereby accepted as fact.
- 2. Claimant has failed to meet his burden of proving by a preponderance of the evidence that he is entitled to temporary total disability benefits beginning April 26, 2019 and continuing through a date yet to be determined.

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We have carefully conducted a de novo review of the entire record

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herein and it is our opinion that the Administrative Law Judge's June 16,

2021 decision is supported by a preponderance of the credible evidence,

correctly applies the law, and should be affirmed. Specifically, we find from
