## OPINION/ORDER

On September 10, 2020, claimant filed Form AR-C, alleging a compensable injury on August 5, 2020. Claimant was represented at the time by Attorney Jeremy Wann, who remains his attorney of record.

On May 24, 2021, Respondent filed a Motion to Dismiss, alleging that it had been more than six months since claimant filed his Form AR-C with the Commission, but he had not made a request for a hearing in that time. Claimant's attorney advised the Commission he had no objection to the Motion to Dismiss, as he did not think the matter was ripe for a hearing at this time, and he and his client would not attend the hearing on the Motion to Dismiss. A hearing on Respondent's Motion to Dismiss was scheduled for July 29, 2021. Notice of the scheduled hearing was sent to Claimant by certified mail at the last address in the Commission's file and was accepted on July 9, 2021. Claimant did not appear in person at the hearing on July 29, 2021.
