ORDER

Respondent No. 1 moves the Full Commission to reconsider our opinion filed May 20, 2021. In said opinion, the Full Commission affirmed and adopted an administrative law judge's decision that the claimant proved she was entitled to temporary total disability benefits from January 9, 2019 to July 9, 2020. Respondent No. 1 states that this period of temporary total disability benefits was a clerical error, and that the administrative law judge meant to award temporary total disability benefits from January 9, 2019 to July 9, 2019. The claimant has replied to the respondents' motion and

agrees that the proper period of temporary total disability benefits is from January 9, 2019 to July 9, 2019. Respondent No. 1 has also appealed the Full Commission's May 20, 2021 opinion to the Arkansas Court of Appeals.

The Full Commission therefore grants Respondent No. 1's motion.

We find that the claimant proved she was entitled to temporary total disability benefits from January 9, 2019 to July 9, 2019. All other aspects of the Full Commission's opinion filed May 20, 2021 shall remain in effect.
