## **OPINION/ORDER**

This case comes on for review following a hearing on respondent's Motion to Dismiss.

On October 14, 2020, claimant filed Form AR-C requesting various compensation benefits. On April 14, 2021, an Order was filed by the Full Commission allowing claimant's counsel to withdraw. Since that time no further action has been taken by the claimant to prosecute his claim. As a result, respondent filed a Motion to Dismiss on November 29, 2021. A hearing was scheduled on the respondent's Motion to Dismiss for January 26, 2022. Notice of the hearing was sent to claimant by certified mail and was delivered on December 6, 2021. Claimant did not appear at the hearing and has not responded to the respondent's motion.

After my review of the respondent's motion, the claimant's failure to respond
