OPINION/ORDER

This case comes on review following a hearing on respondents' Motion to Dismiss.

On October 19, 2021, claimant filed a Form AR-C requesting compensation benefits resulting from the alleged August 30, 2021, injury. Since the filing of the AR-C, no further action has been taken by claimant to pursue her claim. On April 21, 2022, respondents filed a Motion to Dismiss requesting that this claim be dismissed for lack of prosecution. A hearing on the respondents' motion was scheduled for June 14, 2022. Notice of the hearing was mailed to the claimant by certified mail on April 28, 2022. United States Postal Department records indicate that claimant received and signed for the notice on May 2, 2022. Despite having received notice of the scheduled hearing, the claimant failed to appear at the hearing and has failed to respond to the motion in any form or manner.

After my review of respondents' Motion to Dismiss, the claimant's lack of response thereto, as well as her failure to appear at the hearing on respondents' motion, and all other matters properly before the Commission, I find that respondents' Motion to Dismiss this claim

should be and hereby is granted pursuant to Commission Rule 099.13. This dismissal is without prejudice.
