Joint Petition Records, Hearing Exhibits

I. Joint Petition Records.

The Arkansas Workers' Compensation Commission (Commission) does not maintain tape recordings of Joint Petition (JP) hearings. The Commission tape records the JP hearings and delivers the tapes to the respondents at the conclusion of the hearings.

Parties may choose to pay for court reporters and/or transcriptions. There is no charge for tape recordings.

II. Hearing Exhibits.

The Commission retains hearing exhibits that are incapable of being microfilmed or imaged for a period of five years after the final disposition of the claim. Unless collected by the introducing party, such exhibits will be destroyed.
